Park Hill businesses create association

Business First of Louisville

Several businesses in Louisville's Park Hill corridor have joined to form a business alliance.

The **Park Hill Business Association** will work to promote the area roughly bounded by Broadway to the north, South 22nd Street to the west, Algonquin Parkway and Winkler Avenue to the south and portions of Old Louisville and the **University of Louisville's** Belknap Campus to the east.

Louisville-Jefferson County Metro Government unveiled the results of master plan for the Park Hill neighborhood last year. The plan included \$2.6 million in environmental and infrastructure projects, the identification of new targets for business recruitment and the creation of a business association to assist existing companies ([Click here to read more about the master plan](#)).

The association currently has 45 members, according to a news release.

Bob Patterson, president and CEO of Consumers Choice Coffee, will serve as president of the association, the release said.

Membership in the association is open to all for-profit businesses in the Park Hill corridor. Meetings will be held every other month.
